These are holidays where people officially have the day off. Clearly, for a festival, someone would still have open shops, and farmers have to work all the time, but there is a general slow-down. Citizens can enjoy any other holidays they wish, but they are not official.

The word in parenthesis () is the associated deity or the place it happens. Thylicia means it is our own holiday, or that I did not see it listed anywhere as a holy holiday. The number in brackets [] is the count of the number towards our 12.

1/1 New Year's Eve/Day (Thylicia) [1]

Just like in our world, there is a pause to celebrate a new year. The day off is 1/1, with the evening being somber, remembering those who passed in the year ending, called Night of the Pale (see 12/31 below)

2/3 Battle of Stagfell (Thylicia) [3]

A day of Celebration of the defeat of the Stag Lord. Torag is becoming increasingly associated with this holiday.

3/1 Founders Day (Thylicia) [2]

Celebration of the Founding of Thylicia, it is a day of festival, parties and joy. Founders are expected to appear at as many events as possible.

4/14 Battle of the Wisps (Thylicia) [-]

Not an official holiday bit it marks the defeat of the Will-0-Wisps

6/21 Sunwrought Festival (Sarenrae) [4]

Day commemorating the defeat of Rovagug by Sarenrae, celebrated with the flying of kites, fireworks, and gift giving.[3]

7/3 Archer's Day (Erastil) [5]

Holy day celebrated with archery contests, bartering for livestock, and the courting of women.

8/16 Armasse (Aroden, Iomedae) [6]

Holy day where commoners are trained to fight and historical tales are told with the hope that someone will learn from them.

9/21 First Brewing (Cayden Cailean) [7]

The date of this religious holiday changes from year to year, but usually occurs about a month after the harvest of crops used for alcoholic beverages. Cayden's priests use this holiday to bless the harvest and reflect on the hard work of the Accidental God's devotees.

Harvest Feast (Second Moonday Lamashan (October)) [8]

Harvest celebration marking the end of many agricultural activities with the coming of winter.

11/8 Abjurant Day (Nethys) [9]

Day of communal strengthening of defenses and the teaching of magic to children

11/18 Evoking Day (Nethys) [10]

Holiday marked by displays of fireworks and magical duels (both mock and real)

11/23 Seven Veils[11]

Celebration of the unity of all races, commemorated by multi-species masquerade balls

12/21 Crystalhue (Shelyn) [12]

Holiday marked by the creation of artistic works, and the start of romantic courtships.

Night of the Pale

Night of morbid revelry, as people wait indoors for the ghosts of last year's dead to pass by their homes. (Actual Day off is the 1st of the new Year)
